MYNIC Berhad (entiti sah MYNIC Berhad dengan No. Pendaftaran Syarikat: 735031-H) ialah sebuah agensi di bawah Kementerian Sains, Teknologi dan Inovasi (MOSTI) dan dikawalselia oleh Suruhanjaya Komunikasi dan Multimedia Malaysia (SKMM).

MYNIC Berhad (legal entity MYNIC Berhad with Company Registration No: 735031-H) is an agency under Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI) and is regulated by Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC).

Aktiviti utama MYNIC Berhad adalah pentadbir tunggal untuk alamat web yang berakhir dengan .my di Malaysia. Sebagai pentadbir nama domain peringkat kebangsaan, MYNIC Berhad memberikan organisasi dan individu di Malaysia identiti jenama yang unik di Internet. MYNIC Berhad mendaftar pelbagai nama domain iaitu .my, .com.my, .org.my, .net.my, .edu.my, .gov.my, .mil.my dan .name.my.

The main activity of MYNIC Berhad is sole administrator for web addresses that end with .my in Malaysia. As the national level domain name, MYNIC Berhad gives Malaysian organization and individuals their unique brand identity on the Internet. MYNIC register a wide range of domain names ie. .my, .com.my, .org.my, .net.my, .edu.my, .gov.my, .mil.my and .name.my.

MYNIC Berhad mempunyai jaringan wakil jualan di seluruh negara yang bekerja 24 x 7 hari seminggu untuk membantu di dalam urusan pendaftaran dan pembayaran nama domain. Wakil jualan MYNIC juga pakar dalam menyediakan perkhidmatan untuk semua keperluan web dan internet, daripada membangunkan laman web, membuka akaun e-mel, web hosting, merekabentuk laman web dan pembaharuan tahunan nama domain.

MYNIC have a network of authorized resellers nationwide, working 24 x 7 to assist in registering and billing activities of domain names. MYNIC resellers are also experts in providing one-stop services for all web and Internet needs, from developing website, creating email accounts, web hosting, web design to annual renewal of domain names. In addition, MYNIC Berhad holds the responsibility of developing top level domain policies and is always in the forefront of domain name technologies, carrying out research projects such as Internet Protocol version 6 (IPv6), Domain Name System Security Extensions (DNSSEC) and Internationalized Domain Name (IDN) and also involved in promoting and training activities for the usage of these technologies.

Functions

MYNIC Berhad administers the name space for the .my top level domain (TLD), including registration of domain names, maintenance and operation of the central database of the domain registry (a central database for .my domain names).

- .org.my - bagi organisasi/aktiviti yang tidak layak dalam kategori lain
- .edu.my - bagi institusi pendidikan Malaysia sahaja
- .gov.my - bagi agensi kerajaan Malaysia sahaja
- .mil.my - bagi agensi ketenteraan Malaysia sahaja
- .name.my - bagi kegunaan individu warganegara Malaysia dan bukan warganegara yang menetap di Malaysia.

- .my - for Malaysian individuals and organizations
- .com.my - for commercial organisation/activities
- .net.my - for network-related organisations/activities
- .org.my - for organisations/activities which do not qualify for other categories
- .edu.my - for Malaysian educational organisations only
- .gov.my - for Malaysian government organisations only
- .mil.my - for Malaysian military organisations only
- .name.my - for Malaysian individual's personal use only.

Chair's Foreword

Sekali lagi, kita melihat permintaan yang tinggi untuk domain .my iaitu dengan peningkatan yang ketara bagi pendaftaran baru nama domain dan pembaharuan nama domain. Peningkatan berterusan dan menggalakkan dalam peratusan pendaftaran baru (29.4%) nama domain menunjukkan pedaffar amat yakin dan mempercayai nama domain di bawah identiti .my.

MYNIC Berhad akan terus meneroka dan memperkembangkan keupayaan syarikat kerana ia penting, termasuklah memacu inovasi dan merubah tumpuan dengan memenuhi keperluan pelanggan MYNIC Berhad. Pada tahun 2011 MYNIC Berhad telah melancarkan .my DAY di Pusat Dadangan Dunia Putra (PWTC) Kuala Lumpur untuk meningkatkan kehadiran .my dalam talian dan menggalakkan penggunaan Teknologi Sistem Nama Domain (DNS) di Malaysia. MYNIC Berhad juga telah memulakan beberapa projek utama iaitu 1MYID dan Get Malaysian Business Online (GMBO) masing-masing dengan kerjasama Majlis Belia Malaysia dan Google Malaysia. 2011 ng juga ia menandakan permulaan Nama Domain Diantarabangsa untuk nama Jawi, Cina dan Tamil.

Sebagai sebuah agensi kerajaan yang bertanggungjawab dan mementingkan keperluan rakyat, MYNIC Berhad turut menyumbang pada program yang berunsurkan Tanggungjawab Sosial Korporat (CSR) melalui rogram 1nita dan Program 2u-School. Bagi program 1nita, MYNIC Berhad telah bekerjasama dengan Jabatan Pembangunan Wanita (JPW) untuk melatih lebih ramai usahawan wanita dalam mengembangkan perniagaan mereka melalui penggunaan laman web. Manakala Program 2u-School pula, memberi tumpuan untuk melatih wakil-wakil sekolah untuk mewujudkan kehadiran sekolah di atas talian secara lebih formal. Melalui program-program sebegini, MYNIC Berhad dapat menghasilkan satu pencapaian yang besar dan bernilai kepada pada pelanggan kami.

Kakitangan syarikat adalah tulang belakang kepada MYNIC Berhad dan pengurusan kakitangan adalah merupakan cabaran utama lebih maju ke hadapan. Syarikat akan terus melabur dalam memastikan pembangunan kapasiti dan memupuk persekitaran yang professional. Selain itu juga, MYNIC kan berusaha untuk memastikan budaya korporat ditekankan melalui penerapan nilai-nilai etika dan integriti.

Once again, we saw continued strong demand for .my domains, with a significant increase in both new registrations and renewals. The continued increase in the new registration rate (29.4%) is particularly encouraging, as it indicates that registrants value their domain names under the .my identity.

MYNIC Berhad has continued to explore and expand in areas it believes are important, including driving innovation and changes focusing on meeting the needs of our customers. We have launched .MY DAY 2011 in Putra World Trade Centre (PWTC) Kuala Lumpur to boost .my on-line presence and foster the adoption of Domain Name System (DNS) technologies in Malaysia. MYNIC has embarked on several key projects namely 1MYID and Get Malaysian Business Online (GMBO) in collaboration with Majlis Belia Malaysia and Google Malaysia respectively. 2011 also marked the beginning of Internationalized Domain Names for Jawi, Chinese and Tamil.

As a people-oriented and responsible government agency, MYNIC contributed significantly to Corporate Social Responsibilities (CSR) through 1nita and 2u-School projects. In 1nita, we collaborated with Jabatan Pembangunan Wanita (JPW) to train more women entrepreneurs in expanding their businesses via the use of websites. While 2u-School focused on training the school administrators to maintain their official online presence. Through these projects, we have a very compelling story in creating greater value for our customers.

People are the backbone of MYNIC and talent management is the key challenge going forward. The company continued to invest in capacity development and a nurturing environment for our professionals. In the meantime, MYNIC strived to enhance its corporate culture with emphasis on ethical values and integrity.

We have worked hard to achieve further financial efficiencies and revenue improvements over the course of the year and as a result our balance sheet remains strong, enabling service excellence in all areas and positioning us well for the future. For the financial period under review, MYNIC Berhad registered a revenue of RM 6.34 million, an increase of 21.6% compared to the previous year.



Tarikh: 27 Januari 2011

Siri pertama seminar 1nita untuk tahun 2011 telah diadakan di Tenang pada 27 Januari 2011 di Dewan Komuniti, Pekan Ayer Panas.

Majlis tersebut telah dirasmikan oleh YB Datuk Haji Fadillah Yusof, Timbalan Menteri Sains, Teknologi & Inovasi (MOSTI) dan disaksikan oleh YB Dato' Noraini Ahmad, Pengerusi MYNIC Berhad dan Penghulu Ayer Panas, YBrs. Tuan Haji Ibrahim Yaman.

Then, DNSSEC was introduced by providing insights on what has changed in the DNS to support the security extensions.

There was some considerations one need to make in implementing DNSSEC. This would help those who intend to implement DNSSEC so that due considerations are made regarding some concerns that arise in DNSSEC implementations.

The training includes practical hands-on sessions to allow participants to gain a better understanding on DNSSEC and how zones are signed.

Total of 28 participants attended this training representing ISPs, Web Hosting companies and universities.






NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS – 31 DECEMBER 2011

1. GENERAL

(a) The Company is acting as the network information centre for Malaysia under the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation ("MOSTI"). The principal activities of the Company are to manage, control, operate, develop and administer the .my country code top level domain, internet names, numbers, addresses, resources and all other related activities and services. There have been no significant changes in the nature of these activities during the financial year.

The Company is a company limited by guarantee, not having a share capital, not for profit, incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia. Currently, the Company has 2 members. In the event that the Company is wound up, a member or a person who was a member twelve months prior to that event is liable to contribute to the assets of the Company a sum not exceeding Ringgit Malaysia One Hundred (RM100).

(b) The principal place of business is located at Unit 3.2 & 4, Level 3, Block C, Mines Waterfront Business Park, No. 3 Jalan Tasik, The Mines Resort City, 43300 Seri Kembangan, Selangor Darul Ehsan.

(c) The registered office is located at Suite 2302, 23rd Floor, Wisma Tun Sambanthan, No. 2 Jalan Sultan Sulaiman, 50000 Kuala Lumpur.

2. BASIS OF PREPARATION OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

(a) Statement of compliance

The financial statements of the Company have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRSs") and the Companies Act, 1965 in Malaysia.

The Company has not applied the following new/revised accounting standards (including its consequential amendments) and interpretations that have been issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) but are not yet effective for the Company:

The Company plans to apply the above mentioned FRSs/Interpretations from the annual period beginning 1 January 2012.

The initial application of the above standards (including its consequential amendments) and interpretations are not expected to have any material impact on the financial statements of the Company.

New MASB Approved Accounting Standards

To converge with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) in 2012, the Malaysia Accounting Standards Board, the MASB had on 19 November 2011, issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRSs) which are mandatory for annual financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141, *Agriculture* and IC Interpretation 15 *Agreements for Construction of Real Estate*, including its parent, significant investor and venture (“Transitioning Entities”).

Transitioning Entities will be allowed to defer adoption of the new MFRSs for an additional year. Consequently, adoption of the MFRSs by Transitioning Entities will be mandatory for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012.

The Company have not early adopted the MFRS Framework.

In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Company will be required to restate the comparative financial statements to amounts reflecting the application of MFRS Framework. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, retrospectively, against opening unappropriated profits.

The Company has not completed its quantification of the financial effects of the differences between Financial Reporting Standards (FRS) and accounting standards under the MFRS Framework and are in the process of assessing the financial effects of the differences.

The Company expects to be in a position to fully comply with the requirements of the MFRS Framework for the financial year ending 31 December 2012.

The financial statements are presented in Ringgit Malaysia (RM).

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(b) Basis of measurement

The financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost basis other than as disclosed in Note 4.

(c) Functional and presentation currency

The financial statements are presented in Ringgit Malaysia (RM), which is the Company’s functional currency.

(d) Use of estimates and judgements

The preparation of the financial statements in conformity with FRSs requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of accounting policies and the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income and expenses. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

Estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimates are revised and in any future periods affected.

There are no significant areas of estimation uncertainty and critical judgements in applying accounting policies that have significant effect on the amounts recognised in the financial statements.

3. DATE OF AUTHORISATION OF ISSUE

The financial statements were authorised for issue by the Board of Directors on

4. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies set out below have been applied consistently to the periods presented in these financial statements, and have been consistently by the Group entities, unless otherwise stated.

4.1 Financial instruments

(a) Financial instruments

(i) Initial recognition and measurement

A financial instrument is recognised in the financial statements when, and only when, the Company becomes a party to the contractual provisions of the instrument.

A financial instrument is recognised initially, at its fair value plus, in the case of a financial instrument not at fair value through profit or loss, transaction costs that are directly attributable to the acquisition or issue of the financial instrument.

(ii) **Financial instrument categories**

The Company has the following financial instruments:

Financial assets

Loans and receivables

Loans and receivables category comprises debt instruments that are not quoted in an active market, trade and other receivables and cash and cash equivalents.

Financial assets categorised as loans and receivables are subsequently measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method.

All the Company's financial assets, are subject to review for impairment in accordance with Note 4.1(d)(i).

Financial liabilities

The Company only has other financial liabilities.

These other liabilities are recorded at its fair value.

(b) **Property, plant and equipment**

(i) **Recognition and measurement**

Items of property, plant and equipment are stated at cost less any accumulated depreciation and any accumulated impairment losses.

Cost includes expenditures that are directly attributable to the acquisition of the asset and any other costs directly attributable to bringing the asset to working condition for its intended use, and the costs of dismantling and removing the items and restoring the site on which they are located. The cost of self-constructed assets also includes the cost of materials and direct labour. For qualifying assets, borrowing costs are capitalised in accordance with the accounting policy on borrowing costs.

Cost also may include transfers from other comprehensive income of any gain or loss on qualifying cash flow hedges of foreign currency purchases of property, plant and equipment. Purchased software that is integral to the functionality of the related equipment is capitalised as part of that equipment.

When significant parts of an item of property, plant and equipment have different useful lives, they are accounted for as separate items (major components) of property, plant and equipment.

Gains or losses on disposal of an item of property, plant and equipment are determined by comparing the proceeds from disposal with the carrying amount of property, plant and equipment and are recognised net within "other income" and "other expenses" respectively in profit or loss.

(ii) **Subsequent costs**

The cost of replacing part of an item or property, plant and equipment is recognised in the carrying amount of the item if it is probable that the future economic benefits embodied within the part will flow to the Company, and its cost can be measured reliably. The carrying amount of the replaced part is derecognised to profit or loss. The costs of the day-to-day servicing of property, plant and equipment are recognised in profit or loss as incurred.

(iii) **Depreciation**

Depreciation is calculated over the depreciable amount, which is the cost of an asset, or other amount substituted for cost, less its residual value.

Depreciation is recognised in profit or loss on a straight line basis over the estimated useful lives of each part of an item of property, plant and equipment at the following rate:

IT equipments	20%
Furniture and fittings	10%
Motor vehicles	10%
Office equipment	20%
Renovation and improvement	10%

Depreciation methods, useful lives and residual value are reviewed and adjusted as appropriate at end of the reporting period.

(c) **Cash and cash equivalents**

Cash and cash equivalents consist of cash in hand and balances which have an insignificant risk of changes in value. For the purpose of the statement of cash flows, cash and cash equivalents are presented net of bank overdrafts and pledged deposits.

Cash and cash equivalents are categorised and measured as loans and receivables in accordance with policy Note 4.1(a)(ii).

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(d) Impairment**(i) Financial assets**

An impairment loss in respect of loans and receivables is recognised in profit or loss and is measured as the difference between the asset's carrying amount and the present value of estimated future cash flows discounted at the asset's original effective interest rate. The carrying amount of the asset is reduced through the use of an allowance account.

(ii) Non-financial assets

The carrying amounts on non-financial assets are reviewed at the end of each reporting period to determine whether there is any indication of impairment. If any such indication exists, then the asset's recoverable amount is estimated.

For the purpose of impairment testing, assets are grouped together into the smallest group of assets that generates cash inflows from continuing use that are largely independent of the cash flows of other assets or groups of asset (the "cash-generating unit").

The recoverable amount of an asset or cash-generating unit is the greater of its value in use and its fair value less costs to sell. In assessing value in use, the estimated future cash flows are discounted to their present value using a pre-tax discount rate that reflects current market assessments of the time value of money and the risks specific to the asset.

An impairment loss is recognised if the carrying amount of an asset or its cash-generating unit exceeds its recoverable amount.

Impairment losses are recognised in the profit or loss. Impairment losses recognised in respect of cash-generating units are allocated first to reduce the carrying amount of any goodwill allocated to the units and then to reduce the carrying amount of the other assets in the unit (groups of units) on a *pro rata* basis.

Impairment losses recognised in prior periods are assessed at the end of each reporting period for any indications that the loss has decreased or no longer exists. An impairment loss is reversed if there has been a change in the estimates used to determine the recoverable amount since the last impairment loss was recognised.

An impairment loss is reversed only to the extent that the asset's carrying amount does not exceed the carrying amount that would have been determined, net of depreciation or amortisation, if no impairment loss had been recognised. Reversals of impairment losses are credited to profit or loss in the year in which the reversals are recognised.

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(e) Provisions

A provision is recognised if, as a result of a past event, the Company has a present legal or constructive obligation that can be estimated reliably, and it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation. Provisions are determined by discounting the expected future cash flows at a pre-tax rate that reflects current market assessment of a time value of money and the risks specific to the liability. The unwinding of the discount is recognised as finance cost.

(f) Revenue**(i) Services**

Revenue represents the invoiced value of services rendered after allowance for commission paid to agents.

(ii) Government grants

Government grants are recognised initially as deferred income at fair value when there is reasonable assurance that they will be received and that the Company will comply with the conditions associated with the grant.

Grants that compensate the Company for expenses incurred are recognised in profit or loss as other income on a systematic basis in the same periods in which the expenses are recognised.

Grants that compensate the Company for the cost of an asset are recognised in profit or loss on a systematic basis over the useful life of the asset.

(g) Income tax

Income tax expense comprises current and deferred tax. Income tax expense is recognised in profit or loss except to the extent that it relates to a business combination or items recognised directly in equity or other comprehensive income.

Current tax is the expected tax payable on the taxable income for the year, using tax rates enacted or substantively enacted by the end of the reporting period, and any adjustment to tax payable in respect of previous years.

Deferred tax is recognised using the liability method, providing for temporary differences between the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities in the statement of financial position and their tax bases.

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Deferred tax is not recognised for the following temporary differences: the initial recognition of goodwill, the initial recognition of assets or liabilities in a transaction that is not a business combination and that affects neither accounting nor taxable profit or loss. Deferred tax is measured at the tax rates that are expected to apply to the temporary differences when they reverse, based on the laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the end of the reporting period.

A deferred tax asset is recognised to the extent that it is probable that future taxable profits will be available against which the temporary differences can be utilised. Deferred tax assets are reviewed at the end of each reporting period and are reduced to the extent that it is no longer probable that the related tax benefit will be realised.

A tax incentive that is not a tax base of an asset is recognised as a reduction of tax expense in profit or loss as and when it is granted and claimed. Any unutilised portion of the tax incentive is recognised as a deferred tax asset to the extent that it is probable that future taxable profits will be available against which the unutilised tax incentive can be utilised.

(h) **Employee benefits**

Short term employee benefits

Short-term employee benefit obligations in respect of salaries, annual bonuses, paid annual leave and sick leave are measured on an undiscounted basis and are expensed as the related service is provided.

A liability is recognised for the amount expected to be paid under short-term cash bonus or profit-sharing plans if the Company has a present legal or constructive obligation to pay this amount as a result of past service provided by the employee and the obligation can be estimated reliably.

The Company's contributions to statutory pension funds are charged to profit or loss in the year to which they relate. Once the contributions have been paid, the Company has no further payment obligations.

(c) Credit risk

Credit risk is the risk of a financial loss to the Company if a customer or counterparty to a financial instrument fails to meet its contractual obligations.

The Company's exposure to credit risk arises principally from its receivables from customers and loans and advances to related companies.

(i) Receivables

Risk management objectives, policies and processes for managing the risk

Management has a credit policy in place and the exposure to credit risk is monitored on an ongoing basis. Normally, credit evaluations are performed on customers requiring credit over a certain amount.

Exposure to credit risk, credit quality and collateral

As at the end of the reporting period, the Company has only domestic receivables. The maximum exposure to credit risk arising from receivables is represented by the carrying amounts in the statement of financial position.

Management has taken reasonable steps to ensure that receivables that are neither past due nor impaired are stated at their realisable values. A significant portion of these receivables are regular customers that have been transacting with the Company. The Company uses ageing analysis to monitor the credit quality of the receivables. Any receivables having significant balances past due more than 60 days, which are deemed to have higher credit risk, are monitored individually.
